A document called ISEE Parificata
and some Consular documents



How do I get Isee Parificata?

- a. In an italian CAF Office (see list on edisu website from july)
- b. Sending someone on YOUR behalf (procedure will be described in the scholarship call)



Which are the required documents?

- family members certificate *
- income of the family for 2021 *
- the bank accounts/deposits possessed by each adult member included in the family unit (also student and siblings) on 31 December 2021 (translated in english)
- Buildings and land possession - if applicable at 31st December 2021 (translated and legalized by the Italian Embassy)
- Buildings ownership value/revenue - if applicable (translated and legalized by Italian Embassy) – in Square meters
- house rents of your family - if applicable*
- all the family business income of 2021 - if applicable*

*TRANSLATED in Italian AND LEGALIZED

CHECK THE STUDENTS GUIDELINES IN JULY FOR THE UPDATED LIST OF DOCUMENTS REQUIRED



Be Careful...

These documents must be issued in 2023.

NO AFFIDAVIT OR SELF DECLARATION ACCEPTED!

The consular declaration must attest also the “missing” things (i.e. “non working”, “no house possession”, “no bank account on his/her name”)

SPECIAL NOTE: for those who have a passport with only the given name and not the family name, BE CAREFUL in your visa request... don't split your name, but fill the request with ONLY the given name.

Be Careful...

Whenever there is an adult family member without a bank account, this info must be specified: only for this info, an affidavit or a notary certificate is acceptable, but it must be translated into Italian and legalized.

If students do not provide this info referred to all the adult family members, they will be excluded

CHECK THE STUDENTS GUIDELINES IN JULY FOR FINAL UPDATE

Students coming from particularly poor countries

must submit a single certificate, issued by the Italian diplomatic mission in their home countries, attesting that the student does not belong to a family known for its high incomes and its high social level.

Particularly poor countries are:


Afghanistan, Angola, Bangladesh, Benin, Bhutan, Burkina Faso, Burundi, Cambodia, Chad, Comoros, Congo (Democratic Republic of), Korea (Democratic Republic of), Eritrea, Ethiopia, Gambia, Djibouti, Guinea, Guinea Bissau, Equatorial Guinea, Haiti, Kiribati, Laos (People's Democratic Republic of), Lesotho, Liberia, Madagascar, Malawi, Mali, Mauritania, Mozambique, Myanmar, Nepal, Niger, Central African Republic, Rwanda, Sao Tome and Principe, Senegal, Sierra Leone, Salomon (Islands), Somalia, Sudan, South Sudan, Syria, Tanzania, East Timor, Togo, Tuvalu, Uganda, Vanuatu, Yemen, Zambia, Zimbabwe

How do I submit the ISEE Parificato to EDISU?

By post mail (by carrier/courier) or you can bring it to the Students Office/Sportello

Further details on the procedures will be written in the Guidelines

Beware! The submission of the ISEE Parificato certificate is not enough to complete the application: you must submit also the original consular documents above. The documents must be submitted by the established deadlines.



Lets' revise the steps so far:

1. Collect all the consular documents
2. Make ISEE Parificata
3. Arrive in Italy before the deadline and go to EDISU DESKS or send all the documents via post mail within the deadline

PLEASE: for any ticket to EDISU allow at least 2 working days for the reply, don't send multiple requests or you will cause a general delay in all the answer.




STEP 1

Register to EDISU Online Services



STEP 2

Submission of the documents in person in a sealed envelope or by post mail.
Documents must arrive within the deadline



DEADLINES

SCHOLARSHIP AND ACCOMODATION: SEPTEMBER 2° AT NOON (ITALIAN TIME)

SCHOLARSHIP ONLY: SEPTEMBER 30° AT NOON (ITALIAN TIME)

DEADLINES ARE MANDATORY FOR THE TRANSMISSION OF THE REQUEST

USUALLY ASKED DEADLINE REQUIREMENTS

- a) Application form, signed;
- b) Copy of the passport main page and signature page, in black and white, scanned on a single sheet
- c) Consular documents
- d) ISEE Parificata
- e) Study visa
- f) Official fiscal code (can be requested to the Embassy)

IF YOU MISS SOME DOCUMENTS

EDISU WILL NOTIFY YOU

DON'T WAIT LAST MINUTE FOR THE SUBMISSION
OR EDISU WON'T HAVE ENOUGH TIME TO CHECK
THEM AND TELL YOU IF SOMETHING IS MISSING



Visa delay

Students who apply for the accommodation but have a delay on the issueing of the visa due to the Embassy, usually have some delayed deadlines by EDISU

RESULTS

ACCOMODATION*:- TEMPORARY LIST OF ELIGIBLES beginning of SEPTEMBER
- FINAL mid SEPTEMBER **
(WINNER, ELIGIBLE, EXCLUDED, SUSPENDED)

SCHOLARSHIP: - TEMPORARY LIST OF ELIGIBLES end of SEPTEMBER
- FINAL LIST mid DECEMBER (WINNER, ELIGIBLE, EXCLUDED)



*Usually, ONLY TWO PLACE AVAILABLE FOR 1° YEAR STUDENTS

** YOU MUST ACCEPT ACCOMODATION BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 21° AND 26°

IF YOU WIN THE SCHOLARSHIP



You will receive the first 50% installment by January 2024

In order to get the remaining 50%, you need to register 20 CREDITS by April 30th.

The 50% will be accredited in the month of July 24



WHAT IF I DON'T REACH 20 CREDITS BY APRIL 30° 2024?

you still have time to reach 20 CREDITS by August 24 to get the remaining money by December 2024

IF YOU FAIL THIS LAST CHANCE, YOU WILL HAVE TO GIVE ALL THE MONEY YOU RECEIVED BACK TO EDISU ADN PAY UNIVERSITY TAXES

UPO STUDENTS OFFICE OF YOUR DEPARTMENT






IF YOU ARE EXCLUDED FOR ANY REASON,
